Based on the Record on remand from the Court of Appeals,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECLARED that Oregon Administrative Rule [OAR] 291-131-0025(8) (1998), pursuant to which the Oregon Department of Corrections prohibits all incoming mail at institutions under its management except express mail, priority mail, first-class mail or periodicals mail, is unconstitutional as applied to subscription non-profit organization mail.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that defendants are permanently enjoined from enforcing OAR 291-131-0025(8) (1998) or any other rule that prohibits inmates at





subscription non-profit organization mail mailed at standard mail rates.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that upon rejection of any item of subscription non-profit organization mail mailed at standard mail rates, defendants shall afford the sender and the intended recipient notice and opportunity to contest the rejection.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that plaintiffs are entitled to an award of attorney fees and expenses in the amount of \$58,059.47.
