On November 27, 2011 at about 1:45pm, I was briefed by Captain Scott on the status of I/M Halverson Michael #7299859. Inmate Halverson was taken to from OSCI to Salem Hospital on November 21, 2011 for an attempted suicide. Capt. Scott had stated that Dr. Shelton was in contact with the family and at 1:12pm, [REDACTED] sometime today. I received a call from Officer J. Wunderlin at about 2:17pm. Officer Wunderlin was assigned to Hospital Watch and was supervising I/M Halverson. I/M Halverson was [REDACTED] At 2:32pm, I received another call from Officer J. Wunderlin that I/M Halverson's declared time of death was 2:30pm. I directed Officer J. Wunderlin to start a crime scene log and I contacted OSP dispatch (Laurie). Dispatch then notified OSP detective Sara Kelly at 2:55pm and Medical Examiner Rodge Womac at 2:35pm. I contacted Dr. Shelton at 2:55pm [REDACTED] and time of death. At 3:35pm, the Medical Examiner and OSP detective released the body of inmate Halverson. I then contacted Nancy at Alternative burial and cremation at 3:45pm and passed the necessary information for pick-up of the body. Officer J. Wunderlin stayed with the body until Jeremy Roder of Alternative burial and cremation had picked up the body from Salem Hospital at 5:15pm. During this process, OSCI Health Service staff William Cahal was provided current information up to the time of death.

4. Specific Information: (Personal injury, property damage, notification of kin).

Salem Hospital Staff had been in contact with Adele Halverson, the mother of inmate Halverson, Michael. Salem Hospital also notified Ms. Halverson of her son's time of death. Follow up contact could not be established with the mother by OSCI.

On 11-27-11 I was hospital watch security officer on duty at Salem Memorial Hospital in regard to Inmate Halverson Michael #7299859. Inmate Halverson was on [REDACTED] approx 2:17 pm. Per the family thru Dr. Shelton, [REDACTED] [REDACTED] Mr. Halverson died at approx. 2:30 pm. I had called Lt. Goodman with updates and instructions regarding this procedure. A crime scene log was started and the room was evacuated and secured until State Police and the Medical Examiner arrived. At 3:35 pm, the Medical examiner and state police released the body. I remained at the scene until Alternative burial and cremation services arrived and took possession of the body at 5:15pm.
