I AM WRITING TO EXPRESS MY CONCERN OVER THE EXORBITANT COSTS OF TELEPHONE CALLS HERE IN THE V.A. D.O.C. I HAVE BEEN INCARCERATED FOR 17 YRS. AND HAVE LOST NUMEROUS CONNECTIONS WITH FAMILY AND FRIENDS BEHIND THE ENABILITY TO AFFORD THE PHONE CALLS. THEY HAVE HAD TO PAY ANYWHERE BETWEEN \$1.00 AND \$15.00 FOR A FIFTEEN MINUTE CALL. THIS HAS BEEN A BURDEN THAT MY IMMEDIATE FAMILY HAVE HAD TO CARRY. I HAVE FIFTEEN NUMBERS ON MY CALL LIST BUT CAN ONLY USE ONE REGULARLY. THIS IS NOT ONLY UNFAIR TO THOSE ACCEPTING THE CALLS IT IS UNNECESSARY. IT ONLY DISRUPTS FAMILY TIES IN A SYSTEM THAT CLAIMS TO WANT TO STRENGTHEN THEM. THERE IS IRREVOCABLE HARM BEING DONE TO PRISONERS AND THEIR FAMILIES WHO HAVE NO OPTIONS WHEN IT COMES TO THE COSTS TO TALK TO THEIR LOVED ONES.

THIS IS NOTHING SHORT OF EXTORTION BY THE PRISON SYSTEM. PLEASE LOOK INTO THIS AND FIND US SOME RELIEF.



TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

My name is Dale Pughley #1108900 and I am a prisoner at Sussex II State Prison in Waverly Co. Virginia. I've been in prison for nearly fifteen years and I've been subjected to the exorbitant phone rates of private co. phone contracts the entire time. Here in Virginia if your call is local then it's a one(1) dollar flat rate. if however if you're one(1) mile outside of that then your calls cost go up to (\$7.00) seven dollars. Moreover, if your family is out of state your calls rate begins at \$11.00 a call and increases the further away the state is that you're calling. The private Co. that's contracted by the V.A. D.O.C. is "Global Tel". They are sharks! To ensure that they get every penny they limit credit calls to a \$50 minimum. Yet, if you set up a prepaid Debit account you can call all that you want. This legal extortion scheme impacts the relationships of prisoners and their families who are unable to hold up the cost of maintaining a strong line of communication with their incarcerated loved ones. Keep in mind that phone calls last (20) TWENTY minutes. The privatization of many prison services has led to poorer services and contributed to a more 'ANTI-SOCIAL' attitude among prisoners who in most case will be released. This seemingly minor problem actually carries significant consequences and needs to be stopped. Thank you for attempting to correct this wrong.

My reason for writing you is concerning the over price for phone call here in the Virginia Prison System. Which are more for some and less for other (for example) My Family lives in the tidewater area (area code 757) and it cost me \$7.00 dollars a phone^{call} but a inmate that lives in Richmond which is a hour away (area code 804) only has to pay \$90 which is \$6.10 less that's unfair. The only way a Virginia inmate receive fair phone rates is if he has a (804 area code) out side of that he is over price. My research found that based on data from 2007-2008, 42 states receive kick backs or other payments from prison phone service companies, averaging 41.9% of gross revenue from prison phone calls, which generate over \$152 million per year in commission payments. In February 2011, the Michigan Department of corrections (MDOC) entered into a phone contract with Public Communications Services, Inc. (PCS), which is owned by Global Tel*Link - the nation's largest prison telecommunications company. Michigan is one of only 8 states that do not accept commission kick backs. I would really appreciate it if you could look in this matter...

Mr. Genachowski,

When my fiancée gave me her land line number to call. I put it on my phone list. It was approved and the first month was okay. Then Global Tel contacted her and said she had to do a collect call contract with them or I wouldn't be able to call collect.

After she set up the contract for collect calls with Global Tel. Which included the stipulation that they get paid for the collect calls. They also stated that I could only call a limit of 100 calls. Then she would have to pay Global Tel for the collect calls. This causes her to have two separate phone bills. If she do not pay the collect call bill for global Tel by its due date. The collect call limit drop to 50 limited calls. Each time she miss a due date the limit drops. If it drop to 0, she have to pre-pay in order for me to call collect.

The inconvenience of this is a problem in her budget schedule with her own phone company. The bill due date for her phone company is different than Global Tel collect call bill due date. So she have to pay two different bills at two different times in the month. For the same phone usage of time. Global Tel is regulating her access to collect calls from me. Instead of one monthly phone bill she is paying two. This block any deal she can make with her own phone service as its a business phone line service.

My name is Lester B. Lynch, Jr., and I'm a prisoner, currently residing at Sussex II State Prison, and before transferring here, I was at Wallens Ridge State Prison, in Big Stone Gap, Va. I'm a native of Norfolk, Va., where my family resides (Tidewater Area), and calling home from Wallens Ridge, through Global-tel, costs me and my family \$7 a call, which is a lot of money for us because we're not that fortunate as far as having extra/spare money, to be able to pay for calls at that amount on a monthly basis, considering economic conditions. Once I was transferred to Sussex II (only an hour away from home), from Wallens Ridge (at least 12 hrs. away) I assumed that the costs of calls would've dropped a significant amount, but once my family received their bill, the cost per call (\$7) remained the same, and it's difficult to afford these high costs when you have four kids that require your assistance, financially, on a state prison paycheck. I'm unable to see my children due to lack of transportation availability, but being able to call home and hear their voices helps ease burdens of my absence, on both ends, but Global-tel's high prices makes this nearly impossible, and the "only remedy" is another alternative: Global-tel.
